# RYAN WHITE HIV SERVICES PROGRAM

The Marion County Public Health Department Ryan White HIV Services Program is designed to help individuals with HIV obtain comprehensive primary health care. HIV-positive individuals can work with a care coordinator/case manager, physician or nurse practitioner to develop a treatment and care plan to help them improve their quality of life.

#### **ACCESS TO CARE**

Getting the medical care you need if you are HIV-positive can be difficult. Even if you earn a limited income, do not have health insurance or are on Medicaid, you could be eligible for the Marion County Public Health Department Ryan White HIV Services Program.

#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

To be eligible for the Marion County Public Health Department Ryan White HIV Services Program you must:

- 1. Be HIV-positive
- 2. Have a household income less than 300 percent of the federal poverty level (FPL)
- 3. Be a resident of the Indianapolis Transitional Grant Area (TGA)

Marion, Hamilton, Boone, Hancock, Hendricks, Shelby, Johnson, Morgan, Putnam and Brown

# WHAT INSURANCES ARE ELIGIBLE FOR PROGRAM ENROLLMENT?

### Tier One-Full Coverage

**Covers:** All services funded under the Marion County Public Health Department Ryan White HIV Services Program

### Tier Two-RW Limited

Covers: Vision services that are not covered by the primary insurance, oral health services that are not covered by the primary insurance, immunizations that are not covered by the primary insurance, medical and non-medical case management, Early Intervention Services (EIS), HIV counseling and testing, Minority AIDS Initiative, emergency food, medical transportation, emergency utilities, emergency short-term housing, linguistics services and psychosocial support services/support groups.

## Tier Three—Wrap Around

Covers: Oral health services that are not covered by the primary insurance, Early Intervention Services (EIS), HIV counseling and testing, Minority AIDS Initiative, emergency food, emergency utilities, emergency short-term housing, linguistics services, medical case management, non-medical case management and psychosocial support services/support groups.
